Job Description

Job Title: Sound Technician (Full-Time - Hourly)

Reports To: Media/Sound Director

Direct Reports: n/a

Summary - As a Sound Technician you will provide live sound reinforcement for church services, special events, as well as the necessary setup and teardown. In addition, sound techs also assisting the Media/Sound Director with day to day tasks.

Duties & Responsibilities

- Mixing live audio for church services, including full-band live worship, speakers, and other media
 - This includes:
 - Prep
 - Setup/teardown
 - Patching/programming (of audio console)
 - Mixing rehearsals
 - Programming/recording to DAW
 - Pre-mixing (mix playback from DAW)
- Mixing live audio for special events
- Conduct A/V training sessions in classrooms/auditoriums to outside groups
- Develop healthy working relationships with volunteers and musicians
- Interfacing with, assisting, and the training of volunteers/musicians who are interested in learning audio engineering
- Clean, maintain and repair equipment
- Assist Audio Director in day to day tasks and projects
- Cross training with media team (video, computer graphics, and presentation software)
- Studio and "Audio For Video" recordings (music, foley, voice-over, etc)

Required Skills

- Knowledge of audio signal flow and audio principles
- Display knowledge of analogue/digital consoles and associated hardware (compressors/FX/gates/etc)
- Knowledge of MacOS & Windows
- Knowledge of Pro Tools or other relevant DAW software/hardware
- Soldering experience preferred
